Are you new to the Dovercourt PS community? Have you been here for a minute, but have always wondered: what exactly does SAC do, anyway?

Whatever the case, we've got you covered! Here are some SAC basics:

**What SAC means:** "SAC" stands for School Advisory Council (you may know it by its former name, the Parents' Council).

**Who we are:** The SAC is made up of parent and guardians from the Dovercourt community. We are all volunteers. Anyone can join!

Why we exist: We engage with the school on a variety of issues and activities relating to student achievement, enrichment, curriculum goals and priorities, school budget priorities, school safety, renovation plans, after school activities, and criteria for selection of new principals.

What we do: All sorts of things! We:

- Raise money for school enhancements through fun fundraisers, such as our fall Dance-a-thon.
- Organize events, like our Fall Open House and annual Spring into Summer end-ofyear festival;
- Plan enrichment activities, such as optional after-school art and STEM programs;
- Support community initiatives, like community food drives; and
- Provide guidance to support our school.

When do we meet: Once a month during the school year, in the staff room at Dovercourt PS.

Every year, SAC elects volunteers to leadership positions to help steer and manage various initiatives. Here are the open roles for 2023/2024:

- Chair (or Co-Chairs): 1-2 positions
- Secretary: 1 position, 1 alternate
- **Treasurer:** 1 position, 1 alternate
- Communications: 1-2 positions
- Events Team: 2-4 positions
- Community Outreach and Ward Rep: 1 position
- Community Rep: TBD positions
- Enrichment: 1 position
- **Greening / Eco Team:** 1-2 positions
- New: Pride Subcommittee: TBD positions
- New: Stop School Cuts Subcommittee: TBD positions

## Save your stuff: Winter gear and Hallowe'en costume swap

We're hosting a swap of Hallowe'en costumes and winter gear at the Welcome Back Open House on October 12th. Donate gently used costumes and gear to the boxes beside the school office before then, and get ready to stock up on the 12th!

#### Fresh from the Farm fundraiser

Want to buy some great local produce while supporting Dovercourt? We've enrolled Dovercourt in the **Fresh from the Farm** program, which provides students, teachers, staff, and parents/caregivers an opportunity to support local growers by buying Ontario vegetables and apples to raise funds.

Dovercourt PS will receive 40% of all purchases!

- **Vegetable bundle (\$22):** 3 lb (1.36 kg) carrots, 3 lb (1.36 kg) yellow onions, 5 lb (2.27 kg) potatoes, 3 lb (1.36 kg) sweet potatoes.
- Apple bundle (\$24): 8 lb (3.63 kg) Ambrosia apples

Here's how it works: By October 12th, place an order <u>using our order form</u>, indicating how you will pay. In **November** or **early December**, our produce will arrive and be distributed from Dovercourt PS. (We will learn the exact date at least 10 days in advance, and will email you to let you know.) After that, enjoy your delicious food!
