STOP SCHOOL CUTS!

Dovercourt Public School is facing serious cuts.
We need your voice to fight them.

HERE'S WHAT'S HAPPENING:

Provincial cuts:

- From 2017-18 to 2021-22, the provincial government cut funding by an average of \$800 per student. The latest budget provides no increases to education funding. With inflation, this is actually a \$47 million cut in real terms. It also includes the end of all pandemic related funding.

Toronto District School Board cuts:

- The TDSB has recently announced their planned staffing allocations. They plan to implement the provincial cuts by cutting 485 positions across the city—from teachers to caretaking staff.

Dovercourt cuts:

- We are set to lose our vice-principal, library support and special education staff. Our kindergarten classes will go up to as many as 32 students each.

These cuts will make our schools less safe and inclusive. They will have devastating effects on our kids, who are still struggling with the impacts of the pandemic. We cannot allow them to happen.
